



2009 By The Numbers

EMPLOYMENT

- 49 Unemployed persons obtained jobs
- 28 Self-Sufficiency participants secured employment
- 28 Participants rose above poverty guidelines
- 42 Degrees earned
- 2 Self-Sufficiency Participants received savings or escrow amounts totaling some \$5,000
- 132 Unemployed Head Start parents obtained jobs

CHILD DEVELOPMENT

- 1,152 Children received health screenings, immunizations and preventive care
- 464 Pre-school children graduated Head Start prepared to enter kindergarten
- 750 Children participated daily in child development and learning activities
- 80 Children received referrals to begin individualized treatment to address their special needs

HOUSING

- 14 ASPIRE participants secured standard housing
- 111 Housing units were improved through home repair and/or weatherization
- 2 FSS Participants became Homeowners
- \$15,000 Amount of funding awarded to Self-Sufficiency Participants for homeownership through Hope VI

FIGHTING HUNGER

- 210 Member Agencies of Second Harvest Food Bank (SHFB) distributed food to 75,000 individuals monthly
- 6 Million pounds of food, enough for 4.6 million meals, were distributed to Member Agencies by SHFB
- 38 Eligible organizations applied and were approved as new Member Agencies of the Second Harvest Food Bank
- 12,302 Seniors received meals through Member Agencies
- 17,000 Households received food through Member Agencies
- 38,308 Meals provided to children in the Backpack Program
- 315,000 Meals served to Head Start children

FINANCIAL CARE

- 4,538 Total number of individuals attending Consumer Education Workshops
- 3,348 Counseling Sessions conducted including Personal Money Management, Debt Management, Comprehensive Pre- and Post-Homeownership, Reverse Mortgage, and Bankruptcy
- 1,001 Individuals participated in Debt Management Program
- 1,432 Individuals in Foreclosure Prevention Program

ACCOUNTABILITY

- 74 New Hires
- 2,023 Applications screened to fill vacancies
- 14 Employees earned promotions
- 479,528 Payroll hours processed, which equals \$5,523,966 in salaries
- 2,992 Requests processed for new items or repairs to existing items
- \$6,381,377 Paid to cover invoices incurred
- 0 Number of findings through the CCAP audit
- 30% Reduction in employee separations over prior year
- 98% Employee Retention Rate for Year
